Fred Michael Tumblin, Sr., 79, of 17 Brushy Meadows Drive, died June 12, 2016 at Richard Campbell Veterans Nursing Home.

A native of Hickory Tavern, son of the late John Eston and Carrie Bell King Tumblin, he was a US Air Force Veteran of the Korean War and the Vietnam War who retired after 23 years of honorable service at the rank of MSGT. After his military service, Mr. Tumblin returned to his home in upstate South Carolina, where he was a member of Praise Cathedral and had successful careers in the automotive and trucking industries.
