



## Frederick James Radebaugh

October 7, 1929 - April 3, 2015

Frederick James Radebaugh, 85, died April 3, 2015 at Laurel Baye.

Fred was born in Newark, Ohio, October 7, 1929 to the late Earl R. and Grace M. Radebaugh. The family moved to Fairmont, West Virginia in 1930.

He was a graduate of East Fairmont High, Class of 1947, also a graduate of Fairmont State College, Class of 1955, member of the Tau Beta Iota Fraternity and served 4 years in the U.S. Navy (1948-1952). Upon graduating from college, he was employed by Owens-Illinois Inc., having worked at the Plants located in Fairmont, WV; Clarion, PA; Atlanta, GA and Duraglas & Technical Center, Toledo, Ohio. Mr. Radebaugh retired in 1984 with 32 years of service as Mgr. Corrugated Quality Assurance, Glass Container Division. Fred moved to Taylors, SC in 1985 and was a member of Taylors First Baptist Church.

He is survived by his two sons, Charles E. Radebaugh of Atlanta, GA and Paul E. Radebaugh, his wife Helen and grandchildren, Emma and Evan of Snohomish, WA and a sister Mary Ellen Layfield of Easley, SC

Mr. Radebaugh was preceded in death by Nelda Grace Summers Radebaugh, his beloved wife of 52 years and his brother Carl William Radebaugh.

A memorial service will be held 11:00 a.m. Monday at Taylors First Baptist Church conducted by Rev. Daryl Hopkins.
