Gordon Wallace Ross, 94, of 2 Badger Drive, died August 1, 2013 at his home after a long illness.

Born September 18, 1918 in Northville, New York to the late Gordon Churchill Ross and Edna Estella Cook Ross, he grew up and graduated from Wilber Lynch High School in Amsterdam, New York. He became an apprentice with Mohawk Carpet Mills and at the beginning of WWII he went to work for G.E. in Schenectady, New York. He was a Lieutenant at East Glenville Fire Department for 20 years and Pack Master for 16 Cub Scout Den groups. He was on the maintenance committees for all the churches they belonged to and sang in all the different choirs through the years. In 1968, they moved to Greenville to help with New GE Turbine plant as a manufacturing engineer, where he worked for 35 years. Mr. Ross belonged to The Lutheran Church of Our Saviour for 32 years.

Surviving are his wife, Winifred Alice Truax Ross; a son, Timothy Ross (Anita); a daughter, Pamela McKinney (Billy); a grandson, Keith Ross; and a granddaughter, Valerie Ross.

A memorial service will be held 10:00 a.m. Tuesday at Lutheran Church of Our Saviour conducted by Pastor Mark Cerniglia.
