



H. Lee Brown

September 23, 1929 - May 4, 2024

Henry “Lee” Brown, long-time resident of Taylors, South Carolina, husband of the late Earline Styles Brown for 58 years, died May 4, 2024, at Windsor House in Greenville, South Carolina.

A native of Travelers Rest, South Carolina, he was the oldest child of the late John and Lucille Bayne Brown.

Lee and Earline married in 1952 and joined Taylors First Baptist church in 1957 where he served as a training union leader, deacon, and usher. At church, he was best known as a long-time usher whose warm smile welcomed all who entered the doors. He was committed to that job until his health prevented him from serving.

A Korean War Navy veteran, Lee entered the military in 1952, was involved in five battles, and had an honorable discharge. After settling in Taylors, he was a member of Hejaz Shrine Temple, the Taylors Masonic Lodge, and American Legion Post #2. He was also an avid fisherman.

While in the Navy, Lee perfected the skill of cutting hair for fellow soldiers. That skill led to a 41-year career as co-owner of B&F (Brown and Fowler) Barber Shop in Taylors along with Dean Fowler.

Surviving are one daughter, Debbie Barefoot and husband Eric; two grandchildren, Jason Barefoot and wife Whitney and Erika Mosteller and husband Tucker; seven great-grandchildren, Hudson, Charlie, Finley Anne, and Henry (named for Lee) Barefoot and Collins, Charlie, and Andrew Mosteller; and five siblings, Claude Brown, Vera Armes, Shirley Richey,

Johnny Brown, and Larry Brown.

Mr. Brown was predeceased by three siblings, Vivian Willis, Doris Carlton, and Ruth Ernest.
