Hallie Johnson Souther, 99, of 165 Goodjoin Road, died August 24, 2007 at Spartanburg Regional Medical Center after a brief illness.

Born November 9, 1907, she was the widow of Willie Hubert Souther, Sr. and the daughter of the late Eber Reese and Mattie Caldwell Johnson. A graduate of Holly Springs High School in 1926 and University of SC, Columbia in 1931, she taught math for 29 years including positions at Campobello, Holly Springs and Chapman High Schools.

The oldest member of Holly Springs Baptist Church, she had been a continuous member for 85 years where she taught Sunday School for more than half a century including 35 years as teacher of the Hallie Souther Ladies Class.

Surviving are sons Willie Hubert Souther, Jr. and his wife Joyce, George Eber Souther and his wife Carolyn; daughters Jo Ann Souther Sloan and her husband Dan, and Jean Souther Jones all of Campobello; grandchildren Danna Sloan Brown of Taylors, Stephanie Souther Hatchell of Lyman, Tara Souther Phillips of Landrum, and Brandon and Ben Souther of Campobello; 4 great-grandchildren; sisters Etolia Blackwood and Mary Sue Fisher of Inman. She was predeceased by sisters Grace McDade, Fay Johnson, Lucille Vaughn and a bother Reese Johnson.

Church by Dr. Tim Clark and Rev. James Hatchell. Burial will follow in the church cemetery.
