Harry Franklin Smith, 86, a resident of the Manning House died Wednesday, April 11, 2007 at Roger Huntington Nursing Center.

A native of Greer, Mr. Smith was the son of the late William Carey Smith and Maude Smith. He graduated from Greer High School and was a lifelong member of the First Baptist Church in Greer, where he served for many years as a deacon and Sunday school teacher. Mr. Smith was retired from the United States Postal Service in 1982. He served for many years on the Greer Election Commission. Mr. Smith was a veteran of the United States Navy, World War II.

Mr. Smith was predeceased by his wife of sixty two years, Frances B. Smith; a daughter, Pamela S. Harrill; and two brothers, Paul W. Smith, Sr. and Tom Smith.
