Helmut Hensinger, 87, died June 7, 2007 at his home.

A native of Germany, son of the late Robert E. and Minna Scharpf Hensinger, he was a U.S. army veteran of WWII, a retired employee of General Motors in New York, and a member of First Presbyterian Church, Greenville. Mr. Hensinger was a member of the Swiss American Club, former member of the Elder Berry Group at First Presbyterian Church, and a member of the Morningside Board at Rolling Green Village.
