Retired MSGT Jack Hirsch, 83, passed away December 6, 2014 at his home. A native of Detroit, MI, he was the son of the late Joseph and Fannie Grossman Hirsch and a member of Lee Road Baptist Church. He was a USAF Ret. MSGT veteran of the Vietnam War, having also served in Japan, Panama, Korea, Thailand, and Saudi Arabia.
