Jack Donald "JDon" Sanders, 91, passed peacefully May 27, 2025.

Born in Lancaster, South Carolina, he was the son of the late J.D. and Wilma Smith Sanders. In his first career, he worked his way up in the insurance business starting as an Outside Collector to Credit Supervisor and traveled to offices to train and turn around branches. 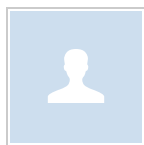
