Carl Lewis "Jake" Belcher, 89, widely known an highly respected resident of upper Greenville County died Sunday, November 30, 2008 in Greer.

He was the widower of Moaitt W. Belcher and son of the late Lewis and Nancy Lula Howard Belcher.

Jake was predeceased by two brothers, Ralph "Charlie" Belcher of Greer and Arnold Belcher of Palm Coast, Florida.

During his long and full lifetime, he farmed, worked in textiles at Greer Mill and retired as a master carpenter with the School District of Greenville County.

Jake was a member of Camp Creek Baptist Church. He was a combat veteran of the United States Army, serving in Europe during the Second World War where he was wounded during enemy attack.

He leaves behind his three sons and their respective families: Myron Belcher of Taylors, Devon Belcher of Greenville and Emil D. Belcher of St. Augustine, Florida.

Visitation will be held Tuesday, December 2, 2008 from 12:00 until 1:30 p.m. at Wood Mortuary in Greer followed by a graveside service at Camp Creek Baptist Church at 2:00 p.m. with Evangelist Marvin Vest officiating.
