James "Jim" Alexander Stott, 86, passed away April 10, 2017 at McCall Hospice House.

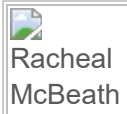

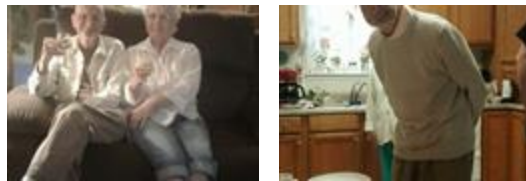
