



## Jean Bateman McAllister

July 4, 1928 - July 3, 2022

Jean Wingate Bateman was born on July 4, 1928, to Elizabeth (Wingate) and Alexander Bateman in Glasgow, Scotland. She had an older brother, William and older and younger sisters, Mary and Elizabeth.

Jean moved to Germany and married Karl Schweier in 1962. The following year, their daughter Sande was born. Karl passed away from a brain tumor just three years after their marriage. Jean was pregnant with their son, Karl at the time.

Jean married Andrew McAllister in 1967 in Germany. They then moved to the United States, Andrew finished out his Air Force career and they moved to a small town outside of Portland, Oregon, Andrew's hometown.

Jean was active in the Presbyterian church and served as both an elder and as church treasurer. She also volunteered to help with church youth groups, Sunday schools, and vacation bible school. Jean's faith was very important to her, and she never started a day without reading the bible and saying her prayers.

In 2002, Jean and Andrew moved to South Carolina. They spent lots of time with their family and were very hands on helping raise their grandchildren and the family pets.

Jean was very saddened by the loss of her husband, Andrew, in 2018 after 51 years of marriage.

Jean passed away on July 3, 2022, just one day shy of her 94th birthday, after a strenuous battle with COVID-19. She is survived by her daughter, Sande

Schweier; her son, Karl (Ruth) Schweier; her sister, Elizabeth Bateman  
Chester; her five grandchildren; and numerous nieces and nephews.
