Jeffery "Jeff" Scott Stepp born July 30, 1966 passed away December 8, 2018. He graduated from Greer High School and received his Associate Degree from Greenville Technical College. He was a retired maintenance supervisor of Mitsubishi Polyester Film and member of Washington Baptist Church. He belonged to the Sons of the Confederacy, was a master gunsmith, machinist and a loyal friend to anyone who knew him.

He is survived by his mother, Linda Morrow Stepp of Greer and father, Mickey D. Stepp of Little River. 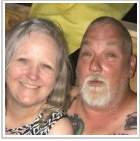
