Jennifer "Jenny" DuBose Carter, 65, passed away February 15, 2017.

Jenny was born in Chicago, Illinois and grew up in Greer, South Carolina. She was the daughter of the late James C. and Ethel Olson DuBose.

She graduated from Limestone College in 1973 where she studied social work and art. She married her husband Joseph P. "Buddy" Carter in 1978, with whom she built a family and two businesses.

Jenny was driven by a lifelong love of learning. Her interest in music, art and social issues enriched the lives of those surrounding her. She found great joy in the service of others which was so clearly reflected in how she lived each day. She was an active member of First Presbyterian Church in Greer and played in the Resounding Joy Handbell Choir. She volunteered at the Greer Soup Kitchen: Daily Bread Ministries. Quite simply, she saw the beauty in life and loved her family, friends, and strangers.

She is survived by her husband, Buddy Carter, her son, Matt Carter (Bridget), daughter, Emmy Carter, step-daughter, Cindy Carter (Liz), sister, Johanna Blackwell (Reece), brother, James T. DuBose, and two grandchildren, Georgia and Geraldine.
