Jeremy Lee Barnette, 44, passed away November 29, 2023.

A native of Spartanburg, son of Jerry Leon and Anita Phillips Barnette of Campobello, he was an educator for Blue Ridge Middle School and a member of His Vineyard. Jeremy was an exceptional musician who played multiple instruments. Jeremy served on staff previously at Motlow Creek Baptist Church as the After-School Coordinator, Children's Minister, and Administrator. Jeremy earned his undergraduate degree in Church Music and Master's in Education from North Greenville University. Jeremy led the Blue Ridge Robotics – 29651 team to a first place win at the State Championship in 2022. The teams have also competed at the Vexs World Competition and in addition won numerous other awards.

Also surviving are his wife, Melissa Merritt Barnette; son, Michael Devan Patterson Barnette and his wife, Halley; and Jeremy's dog, Blu Barnette.

A Celebration of Life will be held at 4:00 p.m. Monday, December 4, 2023, at His Vineyard in Greer, SC, conducted by Dr. Keith Kelly.

Honorary escort will be the educators of Blue Ridge Middle School.

Visitation will be held after the service at the church.
