Jeremy “Brent” Gowan, 48, of Marietta, South Carolina, passed away on October 16, 2025. Born in Greenville, SC, on November 28, 1976, he was the son of Dennis Gowan and Cathey Fleming.

Brent was a devoted father who loved his children deeply and always sought to provide for them. 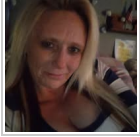

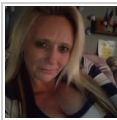
