December 26, 1943 - March 5, 2025

James Hillary Suber (Jim), 81, son of the late Walter H. and Willette R. Suber of Greer, passed away peacefully surrounded by his family after a brief illness on March 5, 2025. Jim was a graduate of Greer High School, Class of 1962, and served six years in the Army National Guard Reserve. Jim lived a life full of adventure, laughter, and hard work.

Alongside his beloved wife, Linda, Jim proudly owned and operated Suber's Corn Mill, where they built not just a family business but a lasting tradition. Now, he takes his place in the heavens as the official corn miller, keeping the grindstone turning among the angels.

Jim was a man who loved life, traveling to new places, and sharing stories—especially about his hunting and fishing experiences. He never met a stranger and had a gift for making people feel at home with his warmth and humor.

Jim leaves behind his beloved wife of 56 years, Linda Bryant Suber; a daughter, Lisa Suber Quick (Steve) of Greer; and a son, Brian Suber (Nicholas) of Greenville. He is also survived by his granddaughter, Kala Stevens (Danny) of Greer, and a great-grandson, James Daniel Stevens. Additionally, Jim leaves behind two sisters, Lucy Turner (Mike) and Mary McDaniel, both of Greer.

Though he will be deeply missed, his stories, laughter, and the values he instilled in his family will live on.

Rest easy, Jim. Your work is done, but your spirit will never fade.

Services will be held on Sunday, March 9, 2025, at Friendship Baptist Church in Lyman, where Jim was a long-time member. Visitation will be from 1:30-2:45 p.m., with the funeral service beginning at 3:00 p.m. Burial will follow in Hillcrest Memory Gardens.
