May 1, 1934 - March 24, 2024

Jo Ann Johnson Allred died peacefully at the home of her daughter and son-in-law on March 24, 2024, in Johns Island, South Carolina at the age of 89. Jo Ann was born on May 1, 1934, in Duncan, South Carolina, to the late Joe D. and Myrtle Sprouse Johnson. She graduated from Duncan High School in 1952 and retired from District 5 Schools in 1997 after working as the secretary of Duncan Elementary for 25 years. She was a devoted and lifelong member of Duncan First Baptist Church and sang in the choir since she was a teenager. Jo Ann was an active and dedicated member of the Duncan community and enjoyed selling tickets at Byrnes football games until she was nearly 80.

Surviving are a daughter and son-in-law, Amy A. and J.C. Renshaw of Johns Island; granddaughter, Anna Renshaw of Atlanta, Georgia; grandson, Ethan Renshaw of Charleston; and nieces, Gay Beiers and Melanie Starnes of Duncan.

She was predeceased by her husband of 53 years, Harold Allred and her sister, Kathie Beiers.

Funeral services will be held 2:00 p.m. Tuesday, March 26, 2024, at Duncan First Baptist Church conducted by Rev. Mitch Crow, in which all are welcome to attend and celebrate her life.
