Joe Malcolm Glenn, Sr., 77, of Greenville, joined our heavenly father on Wednesday, May 2, 2007.

Joe was a native of Greenville and was born and raised in Dunear. He is the son of the late Harrison P. and Ruth H. Glenn. Joe attended Clemson and graduated in 1950 with a degree in Textile Manufacturing. Following college, Joe proudly served as a Lieutenant in the U.S. Air Force, and was stationed in Germany and New Mexico. After completing his military service, Joe began his forty-seven year career in the textile industry. He founded his own company, CarolMac Corporation, in 1990, and retired in 2000 from the company, which is now run by his son. Joe moved to Homewood Residence in 2006 where he was considered family and known for his Stetson cowboy hat. He taught several classes there including a book discussion on David Sobel's *Galileo's Daughter*, and "Writing Your Own Obituary."

Joe is survived by his daughter Susan E. Weeks and her husband Jim of Tampa; his son Joe Glenn of Greer; granddaughters Haley Glenn and Victoria Glenn, both of Greer; and his brother Charles H. "Pete" Glenn and sister-in-law Julia Glenn of Spartanburg.

Joe will be remembered for his ability to tell a good story, his hilarious sense of humor and warm smile, and his love for his family.
