John Robert Carlisle, 93, passed away August 24, 2024.

He was the son of the late Harold Lander Carlisle, Sr. and Mattie Lee Parnell Carlisle of Calhoun Falls, South Carolina, and the loving husband of the late Geraldine (Jerry) Frady Carlisle for 64 years.

John graduated from Clemson College (1953; B.S. Textiles) and enlisted in the U.S. Army with the 97th Signal Operations Battalion (9-14-1953). Upon leaving service, he graduated from Georgia Institute of Technology (1958; M.S. Textiles). He worked for Lyman Printing and Finishing, Monsanto, Greenwood Mills, and Rockland Industries. He was a faithful member of Lyman Methodist Church as well as an avid horticulturist and genealogist. He was also active with the Masons and Shriners as a Master Mason (Orangeburg Lodge 12), a Companion/Sir Knight (Orangeburg York Rite – Eureka Chapter No. 13 R.A.M., Petros Council No. 11 R.&S.M., Orangeburg Commandery No. 9 K.T.), and a Noble of the Mystic Shrine in the Charleston Omar Temple.
