John Louis Moon formerly of 6 Dagenham Drive, died December 1, 2008 at Summit Place.

A native of Greenville County, son of the late Avery and Hattie Rodgers Moon, he was a disabled U.S. Army veteran of WWII, where he fought in the Battle of the Bulge and suffered from frost bite for 60 years. He was a member of Praise Cathedral.

Surviving are his wife, Jean Smith Moon of the home; a step-daughter, Brenda Mahaffey of Easley; a step-son, Garry Owens of Mauldin; two brothers, Clarence Moon and Homer Moon both of Greer; three sisters, Earline Link of Taylors, Jewel Woods of Lyman, and Nellie Quinn of Greer; and three step-grandchildren.
