September 30, 1916 - June 8, 2011

Johnny Lester Sargent, 94, widower of Barbara Ann Garrison Sargent, passed away Wednesday, June 8, 2011 at Greenville Memorial Hospital.

Born in Anderson, S.C. in the Six and Twenty community, Lester was one of fourteen children born to Frank and Argel Dixon Sargent. Mr. Sargent was a veteran of World War II who was drafted into the Army in June 1941. He was stationed at Pearl Harbor and survived the Japanese attack. He remained at Pearl Harbor through May 1945 as a section chief of search light, radar and 6" gun group. After returning home, he married sweetheart Barbara Ann Garrison. Mr. Sargent worked at Greenville Ice Co. and was employed at Armstrong Cork Co. from where he retired after 32 years. He was a past member of Welcome Baptist Church. He was a present member of Laurel Baptist Church since 1961.

Mr. Sargent is survived by son, Dennis and wife Vickie Sargent; step-grandson, Chris and wife Joy Harrison; great-grandchildren, Dylan, Courtney, and Trevor.

Visitation will be held 6:00-8:00 p.m. Friday at Wood Mortuary, Greer, S.C. Funeral services will be held 11:00 a.m. Saturday at Woodlawn Chapel of Remembrance conducted by Rev. Marshall Sargent. Burial will follow in Woodlawn Memorial Park.
