Kathryn Howard Rector, 87, of 2700 Highway 14, died December 17, 2006 at Rosecrest Retirement Center.

A native of Greenville County, daughter of the late Perry W. and Erie Ballenger Howard, she was a retired employee of J.P. Stevens Victor Center, a member of First Baptist Church, Greer, and a member of the Greer Garden Club. Mrs. Rector won the soprano gold medal award at Wellford Lyman Tucapau School for two years.
