Lewis Keith Smith, 86, passed away on Wednesday, December 7, 2011 peacefully at home. Mr. Smith was a veteran of WWII, a master Mason of more than 50 years, and a member of the Shriner's Club. He also served as President of the Greer Optimist Club. He served on the Board of Trustees for Faith United Methodist Church in Greer, SC and was a faithful member there for 48 years.
