Kenneth Alan Baker, 69, passed away April 7, 2017 at St. Francis Hospital. A native of Southend-On-Sea, England, he was the son of Joyce Evelyn Wright Baker of Bedminster, New Jersey and the late Alan Frank Baker. A builder, draftsman, engineer, traveler and painter, he was also the founder of Kab Tech, and an active member of his church. Ken committed many fine works to canvas, but his greatest masterpiece and legacy is the adoring family he leaves behind.
