Kizzie C. Leonard, 83, of 1951 Reidville-Sharon Road, Reidville, died November 12, 2007 at her home.

A native of Elbert County, GA, she was primarily raised in Lyman, SC. She was the wife of the late Waymond W. Leonard and the daughter of the late George S. and Maude Turner Conwell. She is survived by a son and daughter-in-law, Dr. Thomas and Carolyn Leonard of Wilmington, NC, a daughter and son-in-law, Patsy and Larry Farr of Moore, a sister, Betty Jean Conwell Ray of Spartanburg, and five grandchildren, Maggie Leonard, Claire Leonard, Tommy Leonard, Whitney Farr, and Richard Farr. Mrs. Leonard was predeceased by three brothers, Hoke Conwell, John Martin Conwell, and Victor Conwell and one sister, Velma Conwell Powell.

Mrs. Leonard retired as the Postmaster of the Reidville Post Office in 1989 after 15 years, served as a state officer in the National League of Postmasters of the United States, and was named the South Carolina Postmaster of the Year in 1979. She was the volunteer founding librarian at Reidville Elementary School, served as various officers in the PTAs of Reidville Elementary, D. R.

Hill Junior High, and James F. Byrnes High Schools and was a founding board member of the Reidville Historical Society. She was a member of Abner Creek Baptist Church, where she had taught Sunday school.

Graveside services will be held 2:00 p.m. Wednesday at Abner Creek Baptist Church Cemetery, conducted by the Rev. Frank Keels, the Rev. Vernon Thornhill and the Rev. Wallace Hughes. Visitation will be held after the service at the church. The family is at the home.
