We have had the privilege of spending precious time with Dad. After countless doctor's visits, he loved nothing more than sitting down for lunch at a restaurant. We saw firsthand how deeply people respect and cherish our elders—holding doors, offering seats, stopping to chat. And Dad, always smiling, would encourage them right back. Those moments are treasures we will carry with us forever.

Larry was a native of Greenville County, widower of Barbara Bentley Long; a son of the late Thomas Arthur and Addie Winn Long; he was a United States Army Veteran of the Korean War, where he served in the 42nd armored

infantry with Co. A as a squad leader for twenty-one months in Germany. He was the third generation builder of the Long family and owner of Long Construction Company in Greer, and member of El Bethel Baptist Church. Surviving are two sons, Barry Long (Kelly) of Greer, and Mark Long (Deborah) of Greer; one daughter, Joy Johnson (Doug) of Greer; two sisters, Ellen Rogers of Greer and Linda Hunter (Gene) of Taylors; four stepchildren; six grandchildren, Stacey Norris (Russell), Michele Murrell (Chris), Jordan Long (Brooke), Dylan Long (Mary), Jonathan Long (Brittany) and Katelyn Long; nine great-grandchildren; three step-grandchildren, Kyle Johnson, Kimberly Root (Ryan) and Cory Johnson (Amber); and one step greatgrandchild. He was predeceased by two brothers, Gary Long and Tommy Long; one sister, Barbara Selph; his second wife, Hazel Caldwell Long and son-in-law, Mike Lemmons.

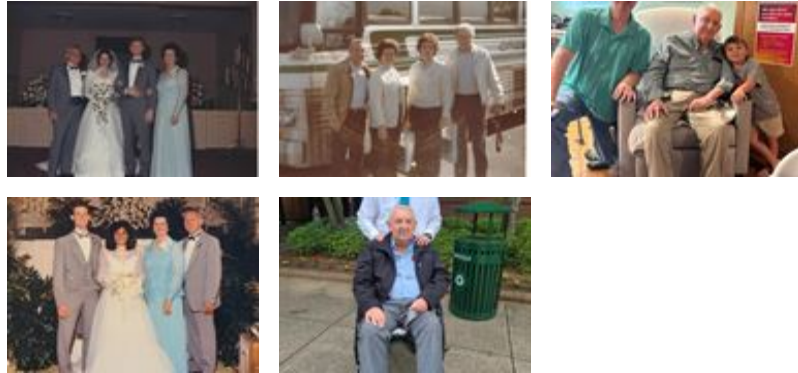
