Lawrence Roger Murray, 87, passed away June 4, 2017 at his home.

A native of Waterbury, Connecticut, he was a son of the late Marshall Mitchell and Mary Emily Sayah Murray. Mr. Murray was a U.S. Army Veteran of the Korean War, having served in the U.S. Army Occupation. He was a retired employee of General Motors and of the Catholic faith.
