Leon Martin Morris, 83, of 102 S. Adams Street, widower of Mary Frances Geddings Morris, died December 10, 2009 at Grady Memorial Hospital.

A native of Barnwell County, S.C., son of the late George Washington and Virgie Black Morris, he was a U.S. Army veteran of WWII, a retired truck driver for Exide Battery and an employee of Penske. Mr. Morris was a member of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints.

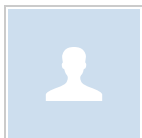

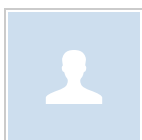
“ *Dear Family,*
