



Leslie "Les" Alan Goldstrom

December 21, 1943 - January 5, 2024

Leslie "Les" Alan Goldstrom Sr., 80, met his Lord and Savior Friday, January 5, 2024, while surrounded by his family.

A native of Vandergrift, Pennsylvania, Les was the son of the late James Goldstrom and Doris Mae Wombacker Goldstrom. He was born on December 21, 1943, in Kittanning, Pennsylvania. He graduated from Bob Jones Academy and in 1968 from Bob Jones University with a B.S. degree in Accounting. He served in the Army and the Army Reserves as a Military Police Officer (MP). He began his career working as an accountant for a large international specialty metals manufacturing company in Pittsburgh, PA. In 1983 he and his family were relocated to Greenville, South Carolina, and he retired in 2007 as President and CEO of Advanced Composite Materials Corporation in Greer. Les dearly loved his family and delighted in spending time together, especially family dinner every Sunday. He was innovative, mechanically inclined, and a man of many interests: woodworking, golfing, completing home projects, gardening, and enjoying his grandchildren. His specialty, though, was making people laugh.

He is survived by his wife of 54 years, Sue, who he met when he accidentally rear-ended her car at a stop sign. Six months later, they were married. He is also survived by his children, Les Jr. (Trisha) Goldstrom, Doug (Jennifer) Goldstrom, Megan (Josh) Luffman, and eleven grandchildren: Madison and Les, III ("Tripp") Goldstrom, Emma (Zane), Douglas, Samantha, and William Goldstrom, Eli, Levi, Caleb, and Canaan Luffman.

He was preceded in death by his father, James, mother Doris, and four siblings: Betty, David, James Jr., and Robert.

A memorial service, officiated by Rev. Roger Barker, will be held at 10:00 a.m. Wednesday, January 10, 2024, at Heritage Bible Church in Greer. Burial will follow at Hillcrest Memorial Gardens.
