



Lewis I. Perry

June 5, 1933 - March 28, 2024

Lewis I. Perry, 90, of Moore, South Carolina, passed away March 28, 2024.

A native of Wilmington, Delaware, born on June 5, 1933, to the late George Wesley and Beryl Irene Horton Cadwell Perry. He was a United States Navy Veteran of the Korean War, served on board the Destroyer USS Lowry DD770 (Tin Can Sailor). He worked in printing for several printing facilities and the Williamston Journal. He retired from USC Upstate in the printing department. He was a member of Elnora United Methodist Church in Elnora, Indiana.

Surviving are his wife of 61 years, Cynthia Martin Perry of the home; two sons, Stephen Perry of Davidson, North Carolina and Timothy Perry (Gina) of Lexington, South Carolina; one daughter, Deborah Rainwater (Evan) of Roebuck, South Carolina; one brother, Marvin Perry (Miriam) of Claremont, Florida; one sister, Lela Perry Weston (Norman) of Delaware, Ohio; five grandchildren, Brittany, Justin, Rebecca, Ava Grace and Preston; and one great-grandchild, Wyatt.

He was predeceased by one brother, Wallace Leon Perry and one sister, Georgina Margurite Timberman.

Lewis loved his country and was honored to serve. He founded the KWWA Chapter 301 in Greenville, South Carolina, in February of 2005. He developed

and chaired the Korean War Veteran's Monument located at Conestee Park on Mauldin Road. Dedication was June 1, 2013. He remained Chairman of the Monument Project until his death. He received the Quilt of Valor and was inducted into the Hall of Heros in Spartanburg, South Carolina, in 2022. He was a member of the Tin Can Sailors Organization and The White River Valley Antique Association in Elnora, Indiana.
