



## Lewis O'Neal Wallenzine

February 14, 1935 - September 5, 2012

Lewis O'Neal Wallenzine, 77, died Wednesday, September 5, 2012.

Born in Laurens County, he was the son of the late Claude and Lillian Wallenzine. He was retired from Choice Point/Equifax. He served two years in the U.S. Army and twenty-six years in the Reserves, earning the rank of Command Sgt. Major.
