Lois Estelene DeYoung Bramlett Hollingsworth died on Thursday, October 5, 2006. She was 85. Born in Greer as the 9th child to Palmer and Ila DeYoung, she married W.T. Bramlett in 1937. Mother to Judy Marlea Bramlett, Lois and Marlea followed W.T. from base to base until W.T. was posted in Cuba as an aircrewman on a PBV performing submarine patrols. When the war ended, Lois, Marlea and W.T. returned to Greer where they operated a credit bureau, Tax Service and Insurance Business.

In 1960, Lois and W.T. moved to Atlanta. Marlea Married Sonny Rhem in 1960 and remained in Greer until her death in 2003. Lois became an IRS Agent in Atlanta and won numerous awards for her service in Taxpayer Assistance. Upon the death of W.T. in 1970, Lois moved back to Greer and transferred to the IRS office in Greenville where she remained until her retirement in 1990. In 1981, Lois married Tom Hollingsworth and enjoyed her retirement with Tom traveling, square dancing and attending Clemson football games. A loving and devoted husband, Tom assisted Lois in their daily outings for lunch and dinner and was with her at Oakmont Nursing Home when she died. Lois is survived by her husband, Tom Hollingsworth and her son, Will Bramlett of Ocean Springs, Mississippi.

A brief graveside service will be held at 10 a.m. Saturday, October 7, 2006 at Pleasant Grove Baptist Church. Following the service, family and friends are
