LTC Herbert Perry Rosamond USA (Ret), of 221 Saratoga Drive, died July 25, 2009.

A native of Alabama, son of the late James Edgar Rosamond, Sr. and Clara Inez Crockett Rosamond, he was a retired LTC from the U.S. Army after twenty-nine years of service and was a highly decorated Veteran where he served in the Vietnam and the Korean Wars . The medals he earned were the National Defense Service Medal, Vietnam Service Medal, Air Medal (1st – 5th Award) Army Commendation Medal (3rd OLC) Republic of Vietnam Campaign Medal, Meritorious Service Medal, Armed Forces Reserve Medal, Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal, Bronze Star, Vietnam Cross of Gallantry w/PALM, Combat Infantry Badge, and Good Conduct Medal. LTC Rosamond was a member of Brushy Creek Baptist Church. After retiring from the US Army he worked for the Greenville County Sheriff Department as a dispatcher and also worked for American Security at the Greenville Hospital System. Surviving are his wife, Jean Edwards Rosamond of the home; two daughters, Patrice R. Davis and Jami A. Rosamond both of Greenville; a brother, James E. Rosamond, Jr. of Taylorsville, NC and his two sons, Eddie and Jeremy Rosamond; four grandchildren, Telly S. McCracken, Shane A. Mahon, Janna P. Frasher and James (Jeep) Perry Mahon and one great-granddaughter, Madison Paige Frasher.

Funeral services will be held 2:00 p.m. Tuesday at Woodlawn Memorial Park Chapel of Remembrance conducted by Dr. Ralph Carter with full military honors.

Entombment will follow in Woodlawn Memorial Park Mausoleum.

Visitation will be held after the service at Woodlawn Memorial Park Chapel of Remembrance.
