Marguerite Boland Reid, 92, widow of M. Hovey Reid, Sr., died September 12, 2006 at Easley Living Center.

Born September 28, 1913 in Clinton, South Carolina, she was a daughter of the late Frank Middleton Boland, Sr. and Ella Sproles Boland. Mrs. Reid was a member of Second Presbyterian Church, Spartanburg, since 1947, a 1935 graduate of Columbia Hospital School of Nursing, and an Industrial Nurse at Spartan Mills for 35 years, retiring in 1978.
