Marjorie Ruth Mitchell, 89, passed away September 26, 2023.

A native of Lancaster, Marjorie was the daughter of the late George W. and Ruth Jordan Mitchell. She was a retired schoolteacher for Greenville County School District, spending her entire career teaching at Greer High School after graduating from Winthrop. She later went on to earn her Masters.

Marjorie was a member of Memorial United Methodist Church, and active in Memorial United Women in Faith. She was a Charter Member of the Alpha Alpha Chapter of The Delta Kappa Gamma International and was the recipient of the Order of the Rose in 2015. She was also a member of the Nathanael Greene Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution, and was awarded The Community Service Award in 2001.

She is survived by many nieces and nephews, grandnieces and nephews, and great-grandnieces and nephews, all of whom she loved dearly.

She was predeceased by three sisters, Sara M. Auten, Betty M. Nivens and Doris Carolyn Mitchell.

A memorial service will be held 2:00 p.m. Saturday, October 21, 2023, at Memorial United Methodist Church conducted by Rev. Perry Evatt and Rev. Dennis Lee.

Visitation will be held 1:00 -2:00 p.m. Saturday, October 21, 2023, at the church.
