Mark Cooper Bailey, 61, passed away December 3, 2020.

Born in Greenwood, raised in Anderson, long time resident of Greenville, he was a son of the late Ernest Stein and Betty Jo Gray Bailey, owner of IndSpec Systems and a member of Mitchell Road Presbyterian Church.

Surviving are his wife, Pamela Anne Swiger Bailey of the home; two daughters, Mary Lindsay Bailey of Rome, Georgia and Sarah Bailey Davis (Forde) of Taylors; a son, Samuel Mark Bailey of Greenville; a brother, Steven G.
