Mark Douglas McGuffee, 68, of Taylors, SC, died peacefully at home on Sunday, October 23, 2022.

Born in Louisville, Kentucky on January 31, 1954, Mark was the son of the late Jack Gilbert and Phyllis Waldrige McGuffee.
