Mary Catherine Vaughn Clapp, 89, passed away peacefully on March 24, 2015 at Greenville Memorial Hospital following a brief illness. She was born in Duncan, SC on October 14, 1925, and was the daughter of the late Joseph Leroy Vaughn, Sr., and Sarah Brissie Vaughn.
