



## Mary Louise S. Hendrix

September 26, 1925 - November 29, 2024

Mary Louise S. Hendrix, 99, a longtime resident of the Abner Creek Community and wife of the late Francis Earle “F.E.” Hendrix, passed away at home on Friday, November 29, 2024.

Born in Lyman, South Carolina, she was the daughter of the late Clarence and Rosalie Mouchet Snelgrove. She was a longtime, faithful member of Abner Creek Baptist Church where she served as pianist, organist, choir member, and taught Sunday School for many years.
