A native of Wheeling, West Virginia, she was a daughter of the late Robert and Evelyn Witzberger West and a member of Blessed Trinity Catholic Church.

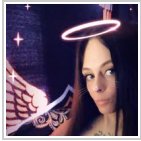

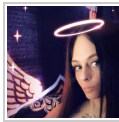

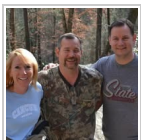
