



Mildred W. Kinnett-Farr

October 30, 1925 - May 5, 2024

Mildred Louise Wilson Kinnett-Farr, 98, wife of the late Forest Edward Kinnett, Sr. and Wesley Farr, passed away May 4, 2024.

A native of Greer, South Carolina, she was a daughter of the late Tureen Newell Wilson, Sr. and Irene Hawkins Wilson. As a young woman, Mildred worked in a beauty shop and went on to get her cosmetology license. She later worked in the sewing room at Pacific Mills, before staying home to raise her only son, Eddie.

In 1959, she went back to work in the field of insurance for Owens Insurance, and later Joyner Insurance. She officially retired in 1996 at the age of 71. She was an active member of her church, Lyman Methodist Church, and sang in the choir for 50 years. At age 98, she was one of the oldest living members of the church. She was a dedicated wife, mother, grandmother, great-grandmother, and loyal friend to many. She will be sincerely missed by her family, friends, and neighbors.
