MSG John David Greer US Army Retired, 73, of 201 Havenhurst Drive, died January 18, 2010 at Greenville Memorial Hospital.

A native of Greenville County, son of the late John Henry and Ruth Lindsey Greer, he retired from the U.S. Army after 32 years of service having served in Korea, Germany, and two Tours of Duty in Vietnam as well as serving Stateside in SC, GA, VA, and LA. He was a graduate of Greer High School, a member of Pleasant Grove Baptist Church and Taylors Masonic Lodge.

Surviving are his wife, Betty Lynn Greer of the home; a daughter, Wendy Campbell and husband Scott of Greer; a step-son, Jay Lamb and wife Kim of Taylors; a brother, Steve Greer of Athens, Georgia; two sisters, Corrie Crook of Greer and Judy Hensley of Baton Rouge, Louisiana; and two grandchildren, Whitney Campbell and Bailey Campbell of Greer.
