Maurice Theodore (Bus) Belue, 81, of 111 Woodland Drive, died December 3, 2008 at his home.

A native of Spartanburg County, son of the late Walter H. and Leona Wilson Belue, he was a U.S. Navy veteran of WWII and the former president of Citizens Building and Loan. Mr. Belue was a lifetime member of Apalache United Methodist Church and a member of Jackson Grove United Methodist Church. He was a member of Bailey Masonic Lodge #146 and the Greer Lions Club.
