Myrtle Ballenger Corbin Lee, 96, widow of B.F. Lee, died February 16, 2008 at Greenville Living Center. She was predeceased by her first husband, Leo Neil Corbin, father of her four children.

She was born October 21, 1911 in Spartanburg county, daughter of the late Alberry Munson and Pearl Maltida Pace Ballenger. She attended Greenville Women's College (Furman) and later became a school teacher. She taught in several upstate rural schools. She later became a Librarian with the Greenville County Library system with which she drove a bookmobile.

Mrs. Lee later was employed by North Greenville College where she worked in the library. Mrs. Lee retired as Post Mistress for the college. She was a charter member of Tigerville Baptist Church and also a member of the Daughters of The American Revolution.
