Nell Elam Hitt, of White Oak Estates, died Monday, April 5, 2010.

Nell was a native of Greenwood, S.C. She was a graduate from Spartanburg Methodist College in 1943 and was awarded a scholarship to Converse College where she earned a B.A. degree in 1944. She went on to the Richmond School of Social Work which, at that time, was affiliate with the College of William and Mary. Her career was spent in Family Service Agencies in Richmond, Va. and Chattanooga, Tenn. As a caseworker, she was supervisor of graduate students and director of Casework Services. In 1967, she accepted the position of Regional Representative with the Family Service Association of America. She relocated to Dallas, Texas as a consultant with 27 Family Agencies in seven states. After retirement, she moved to Duncan, S.C. in 1978. Her hobbies were gardening, golf and volunteer services.

A memorial service will be held 11:00 a.m. Friday at the Universalist Unitarian Church of Spartanburg where Nell was a member.
