“ Dear Family:

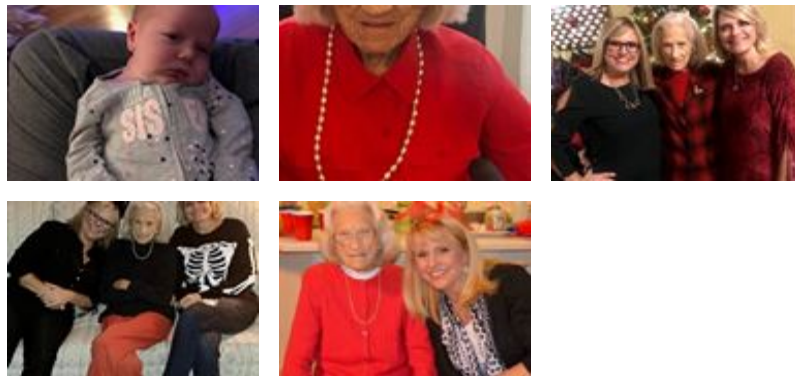

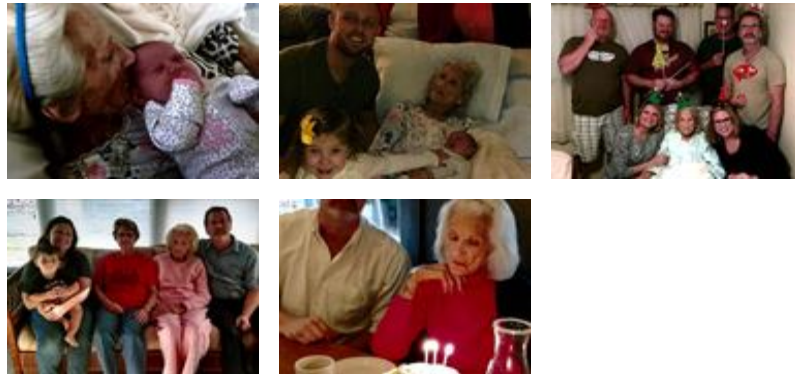
