



Patt Edward Gleason

October 23, 1939 - April 18, 2021

Patt Edward Gleason, 81, passed away April 18, 2021.

A native of Aurora, IL, son of the late Harold E. and Dorothy E. Gleason, he enlisted in the U.S. Navy in June, 1957 and served for four years; trained as a Radarman and served aboard the aircraft carrier USS Bennington; where he attained the rank of Radarman 3rd Class. He retired from IBM, owned his own company Gleason Communications and was a member of Tyger River Presbyterian Church.

Surviving are his wife, Betty Lou Casten Gleason of Simpsonville, SC; one daughter, Barbara Gleason Tripp of St. Charles, IL; two sons, Timothy Gleason of Oregon, IL; Paul Gleason (Ruth) of Crystal Lake, IL; daughter-in-law, Becky Dupont Gleason of Springboro, OH; one step daughter, Ronica Van Gelder (Tim) of Knightdale, NC; eight grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.

Mr. Gleason was predeceased by three brothers, Bill, Jack and Bob Gleason; one son, Patrick Gleason and one step son, Randy Hill.
