Paul George Jones, Sr., 68, who split time between West Orange, NJ and Greer, SC, passed away peacefully on Sunday, May 30, 2010 in Greer.

Paul was born February 19, 1942 in East Orange, NJ to Samuel and Elsie (Kratzel) Jones. He married Linda Crovelli on November 16, 1974. They celebrated 35 years of marriage.

Paul enlisted and served four years in the United States Air Force. After the military, Paul finished his Associates of Fire Science degree at Passaic County College and received a Bachelors degree from Bloomfield College. He served 27 years with the West Orange, NJ Fire Department. He retired as a Fire Captain in 1999.

Paul was a celebrated athlete, being inducted into both his high school's and college's hall of fame for basketball and baseball. He took his knowledge of sports and became a coach. He also enjoyed model trains, traveling, the Philadelphia Phillies, and the Clemson Tigers.

Paul is survived by his wife, Linda Jones; his daughter, Cheryl LaGrone and her husband, Kenneth; his daughter, Jessica Witt and her husband, Matthew; his son, Paul Jr.; his brothers, Carl and Roy; and his grandchildren, Nathan, Sarah, and Elwyn.

Paul is predeceased by his parents and his brother, Norman.

Funeral services will be held 1:00 p.m. Wednesday at St. Giles Presbyterian

Church, conducted by Pastor Matt Matthews. Burial will be in Graceland Memorial Park, Kenilworth, New Jersey.
