Pauline J. Solomon, died April 19, 2012 at Cottingham Hospice House in Seneca, SC.

Born June 15, 1914, in Defiance, OH, she was a daughter of the late Paul P. and Elfa Folk Johnston.

She is survived by a son, Steven P. Solomon of Sarasota, FL, daughters, Vicki S. Schmid and Christine S. Shannon of Seneca, SC, and American Field Service exchange student, Lorenza Artoni Iori of Reggio Emilia, RE, Italy, ten grandchildren and twelve great-grandchildren.
